- 3. **Food Security and Agriculture:** I will support small-scale irrigation and modernized farming techniques to ensure families have enough food for their own needs and surplus for trade.
- 4. **Infrastructure Development:** I will continue to improve road infrastructure, making it safer for children to travel to school and for goods to move efficiently, particularly during the rainy season.
- 5. **Clean Water:** I will expand the drilling of boreholes and work with the Southern Region Water Board to provide piped water, reducing the risk of waterborne diseases like cholera.
- 6. **Public Security:** I will ensure more police units are established to safeguard people and their property, and make sure police officers have proper housing and resources.
- 7. Youth and Women Empowerment: I will lobby for soft loans for small businesses and vocational training for young people, with plans to establish two vocational training centers.
- 8. **Sports Development:** I will promote sports as a means of fostering social cohesion, improving health, and building community spirit.
- 9. **Energy and Rural Electrification:** I aim to bring electricity, including solar power, to every household, enabling small businesses to thrive and creating opportunities for entrepreneurship.
